Demographic Profile Pennsylvania

Population Growth: The total population of Pennsylvania increased by 3.4 percent over the past decade to 12,702,379.

Age and Sex: In 2010, Pennsylvania had a total population of 12,702,379 - 6,190,363 males (48.7 percent) and 6,512,016 females (51.3 percent). The age structure of the population in 2010 was as follows: 25.0 percent of the population was under 20 years old, 59.5 percent was 20 to 64 years old and 15.4 percent was 65 years or older.

Race and Ethnicity: For people reporting one race alone, not of Hispanic ethnicity, 79.5 percent were White; 10.4 percent were Black or African American; 4.4 percent were Other Race Alone. A total of 719,660 or 5.7 percent of the population were Hispanic.

Households: In 2010, there were 5,018,904 households in Pennsylvania. The average household size was 2.45 people. Families made up 65.0 percent of the households. This figure includes both families with (26.9 percent) and without (38.0 percent) children. Of families with children less than 18 years old, 18.3 percent were married-couple families, 6.5 percent were female householder families with no husband present, and the remaining (2.2 percent) were male-headed households with no wife present.

Education: During the period 2008-2012, 27.0 percent of Pennsylvania residents had earned a Bachelor's degree or higher. A total of 1,013,820 or 11.7 percent had not completed high school.

Income and Poverty: Households with incomes of \$25,000 to \$49,999 (24.4 percent) made up the largest percent of households in Pennsylvania in 2008-2012.

In 2008-2012, the overall poverty rate for Pennsylvania was 13.1 percent. The poverty rate for the population under 18 years of age was 18.4 percent, compared with 12.3 percent of people 18 to 64 years and 8.4 percent for those aged 65 years and over. A total of 292,539 or 9.1 percent of all families had incomes below poverty level. In 2008-2012, 15.3 percent of families with related children and 39.2 percent of families with a female householder and no husband with related children present had incomes below the poverty level.

Class of Worker and Occupation: In 2008-2012, 82.9 percent of the workforce was private wage and salary workers; 11.6 percent were federal, state, or local government workers; and 5.4 percent were self-employed in their own (not incorporated) business.


The top occupation group for the civilian employed population 16 years and over in Pennsylvania in 2008-2012 was Management, business, science, and arts (35.9 percent).


